Life in Westminster and the effects of Brexit on teenagers were among the topics discussed by MP Charlie Elphicke and Goodwin Academy students.

The Deal secondary school is working on a project that looks at the impact of government policies on public services.

Their research with the Deal

and Dover MP includes studying what Brexit will mean for the constituency – particularly how Border Force and immigration will be affected.

Mr Elphicke talked to about 20 sixth-formers, and said: "It was fantastic to speak to the students.

"I was really impressed by how much they already knew about

politics – and the passion they have for the subject.

"They are clearly being taught well at the Goodwin Academy. Great strides have been made here in the past year.

"It's so important young people are engaged with politics. They must play a key part in building Brexit Britain."
